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Off Road Course Composition

The off road and recovery courses provide opportunities to experience a variety of terrain with a wide discrepancy in the amount of traction available. During a course the following skills will be understood & developed:

- Drive train, suspension types & their operation.
- Recovery systems & procedures; including winch operation.
- Off-road Driving techniques; maneuvering vehicles in mud, rock, ditches, over obstacles, inclines & declines.
- Terrain analysis.
- Equipment choice, including vehicle & tire choice.
- Vehicle preservation.
- Tire technology & choice.
- Time saving techniques.
- Operation of right hand drive & left hand drive vehicles.
- Left foot braking techniques.
- Spotting.
- Water fording.

These skills will create confidence when driving & a library of techniques to use when the situation deteriorates. Importantly the skills will be applicable to a wide variety of vehicles & equipment.

- Roll over righting.
- Tow point locating & improvisation.
- Dissimilar sized vehicle recovery.
